## **Internship FAQ**

- Grant amount?** Up to \$2,000. Grant recipients must agree to at least match the grant for the intern's compensation.
- When awarded?** No later than March 1, 2024
- How many grants will be awarded in 2024?** A total of \$10,000 will be given out in grants of up to \$2,000.
- Who can apply?** Any MNA full member
- What type of internship is eligible?** Reporting, photography, layout and design, social media, website design/management, newsletter development, multimedia, reader engagement, circulation, advertising sales and design, financial management and more.
- Are there restrictions on hiring of the interns?** Internship employment is open to anyone 16 and older who is interested in pursuing a career in community journalism.
- How will grants be awarded?** A committee of MNA members, who have not submitted applications for internship grants, will rank the applications and pick the applications to receive internships, with preference given to newspapers which did not receive internship grants in 2023.
  
- Who received internships in 2023?** The Boulder Monitor, the Lake County Leader, the Tobacco Valley News, the Cascade Courier and the Daily Inter Lake.
